



TRANSFER CREDIT GUIDE: COLLEGE OF NURSING

If you are a South Carolina technical college student who plans to transfer to the University's and pursue **a major in the College of Nursing**, you should consider the following courses as you schedule your technical college classes. The courses listed below will transfer to degree programs within the College of Nursing. This list does not include every technical college course available for transfer to USC. You are not required to take all courses listed prior to transferring. Rather, it is a guide for you and your advisors. * You should be aware that courses must be passed with a **grade of C or higher** in order to be considered for transfer credit. **You must have a GPA of 3.0 and earned a "C" or higher in each required science course attempted to be considered for admission. Only one course in a required science course (or previously attempted nursing course) for which an unsatisfactory grade is earned may be repeated once to earn a grade of C or better to remain eligible for admission and continuance in the nursing major.** Please review admissions requirements at www.sc.edu/admissions.

1) Two foreign language courses to be chosen from*:

a) FREN 109, 110

OR

b) GERM 109, 110

OR

c) SPAN 109, 110

*Note: Students must have the equivalent of two semesters of study in a foreign language and demonstrate proficiency on the University's placement examination.
