



**TRANSFER CREDIT GUIDE:
SOCIAL WORK**

If you are a South Carolina technical college student who plans to transfer to the University's College of Social Work to *pursue a social work degree*, you should consider the following courses as you schedule your technical college classes. The courses listed below will transfer into the Social Work program. This list does not include every technical college course which is available for transfer to USC. You are not required to take all courses listed prior to transferring. Rather, it is a guide for you and your advisors.* You should be aware that courses must be passed with *a grade of C or higher* in order to be considered for transfer credit. *You must have a GPA of 2.75 to be considered for admission.* Please review admissions requirements at www.sc.edu/admissions.

Laboratory Science Courses:

- 1) BIO 105, 210 or 211
- 2) One laboratory course selected from: AST 101, 102; BIO 101, 102, 112, 205 & 206, 210, 211; CHM 105, 110, 111; PHS 101, 102, 115; PHY 201, 202, 221, 222

Numerical and Analytical Reasoning Courses:

Option 1:

- 1) MAT 130 or 140
- 2) MAT 120

Option 2:

- 1) MAT 120 and higher level STAT course at USC

Foreign Language Courses:

- 1) FRE 101, 102 (equivalent to FREN 109, 110)
OR
- 2) GER 101, 102 (equivalent to GERM 109, 110)
OR
- 3) SPA 101, 102 (equivalent to SPAN 109, 110)

Laboratory Science Courses (8 hours):

- 1) BIOL 110, BIOL 110L, BIOL 243/244, BIOL 243L/244L
- 2) One laboratory course selected from: ASTR, BIOL, CHEM, GEOL, MSCI, PHYS

Numerical and Analytical Reasoning Courses (6 hours):

Option 1:

- 1) MATH 122 or 141
- 2) STAT 201 or higher

Option 2:

- 1) STAT 110
- 2) STAT 201

Foreign Language Courses (0-6 hours):

Demonstration of proficiency in one foreign language (**score of 2 on USC Placement Test**) equivalent to the minimal passing grade on the exit examination in the 122 course. Students transferring credit equivalent to USC 109 and 110 may enroll in USC 122 to complete the required sequence.
