

Work-Study vs. NON-Work-Study Positions

What is a work-study position?

A work-study position is a part time job, available to students who are awarded Federal work-study as part of their total financial aid award package.

Am I eligible for a work-study position?

Work-study positions are available to any student with a Federal work-study award.

A Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is required for Federal work-study award consideration.

What is a NON-work-study position?

A NON-work study position is essentially just a part-time job. The position does not have any correlation to your financial aid award package.

Am I eligible for a NON-work-study (part-time) position?

All students are eligible for non-work study position (part-time jobs), provided that they meet the qualifications in the position description.
