

2011 Carolina Journalism Institute Student Behavioral Contract

(Please bring this contract with you to CJI signed by parent and student).

In consideration of being allowed to participate in the 2011 Carolina Journalism Institute (CJI), CJI students and their parents or guardians understand and agree to the following:

1. **Students are required to attend all sessions for the entire class period.**
2. Students are on their own for meal times. Students are encouraged to walk in groups at all times. Students are not allowed to use private vehicles. Neither CJI nor the University of South Carolina is responsible for any injury or damage to students or students' property during these times.
3. Non-commuting students are not allowed to drive or be a passenger in private vehicles from the time they register Wednesday until the close of the Institute Sunday. No exceptions will be made to this policy. **No student is allowed into ANY automobile (other than an official University of South Carolina vehicle) during CJI. Commuting students should use their vehicles only for transportation to and from the Institute.**
4. Students are not allowed to change assigned hotel rooms. **Students must be in the hotel by 10 p.m., and must be in their rooms by 11 p.m. for room check.** After room check, students are allowed to quietly mingle **on their own floors**. Students must be in their rooms by midnight for the night. **Students are not allowed to visit students of the opposite sex in their hotel rooms, nor are they allowed to be on an opposite sex floor FOR ANY REASON.**
5. Students may not use room phone calls to make long distance phone calls.
6. Students are responsible for any damage to or loss of CJI property or equipment or Marriott Courtyard property (including damage to dorm elevators caused by overcrowding) that they cause. Students must pay for any such damages before the end of the workshop.
7. Neither CJI nor the University of South Carolina is responsible for any injury or damage to students or students' property occurring at the Marriott Courtyard or in any of the facilities the workshop instructors use.
8. Students must be considerate of other Marriott Courtyard guests.
9. Students are prohibited from smoking, possessing alcohol or possessing illegal substances while attending the workshop.
10. Students are responsible for complying with all applicable local, state and federal laws, and the rules and regulations of CJI, the University of South Carolina, their respective schools and the Marriott Courtyard.

Any student violating the terms of this CJI Contract will be dismissed from the workshop. Students either will be sent home or their parents or guardians will be instructed to pick them up. Any expense incurred will be the responsibility of the student/parent/guardian.
