Timeline: August 2007 – July 2010


The CTE will:


Initiate announcements and manage the application processes.  
Interview and recommend applicants.  
Manage Pi budget, including incoming funds from cost-share partners.  
Manage paperwork to hire Fellows and to get them on payroll.  
Arrange instruction for GRAD 800, Fall and Spring.  
Send information on new Fellows to Grad School for GRAD 800 enrollment.

The Graduate School will:

Provide representation on Pi Fellows Advisory Board.  
Distribute announcements through lists and web page.  
Include Fellowship information with Grad School Fellowships information.  
Review recommended applicants and provide feedback.  
Put GRAD 800 on Master Schedule and clear special permission, in-state tuition and initiate enrollment for new Fellows.  
Provide financial support for GRAD 800 in the Fall 2007 term as agreed in original grant cost-share.  
Honor cost-share commitment to Fellow salaries, Fall 2007 – Spring 2008.
