Graduate Fellowships	
Crockcroft Fellowship Leadership Development Program	A program to prepare nurses for leadership in the 21st Century.
George H. Deiter and Molly E. Royem Fellowship	Awarded to a graduate student enrolled in the psychiatric community mental health nursing major or in another graduate major if no one from the psych major applies and/or is eligible. Preference shall be given to a student doing research on alcohol and substance abuse.
Myrtle I. Brown Fellowship	Established to provide fellowships for nurses pursuing advanced degrees in nursing. Priority for doctoral study, but Master's level students may apply.
Opal F. Brown Bicentennial Fellowship Fund	This scholarship will be awarded to a talented, full-time graduate student(s) to be named the Opal F. Brown Scholar(s).
Loomis-Wood Doctoral Nursing Fellowship	For support of PhD students enrolled in the College of Nursing.

Dunn-Shealy Professorship	To fund a Professorship in Nursing.
Emily M. Smith Professorship	To fund a Professorship in Nursing.

Betty M. Johnson Excellence in Teaching Award	The College of Nursing Dean's Administrative Council (DAC) or other appropriate administrative committee shall propose appropriate expenditure of the funds with final approval by the Dean of the College of Nursing . Annual faculty awards will be the priority, recognizing faculty who excel in teaching. In addition, funds may be awarded to selected faculty for teaching development.
