What is it? It's a FREE, FAST and CONVENIENT online exchange/recycling "shopping mall" to help people with disabilities & seniors with functional limitations find, give or sell affordable assistive technology devices & equipment. On the web: <http://www.sc.edu/scatp/scatpexchange.htm>

Where is it? Go to www.scatpexchange.net, click "I've read and accept the terms." and go to the next page. Click "register" and it should be easy from there. You can register even if you don't have items to sell, give or find. You'll have a password & can look anytime.

Examples of types of items? Daily Living (lifts, CPAP, bathing), Environmental Adaptations (ramps), Mobility, Seating & Positioning (wheelchair, scooter, beds, standing table, stroller, gait trainer), Vehicle Modification & Transportation (van, car, hand controls, lifts), Computers, Hearing, Recreation, Sports & Leisure, Speech Communication, etc.
