Graduate Assistantship in Clarinet

Responsibilities

The *Clarinet Graduate Assistant* provides studio instruction for non-music majors, lower-division music majors and clarinet methods class. Responsibilities require up to 18 hours per week, and the nine-month stipend ranges from \$5,700 to \$6,300. Tuition abatements and compensation for performance in ensembles may boost the total value of the position above \$25,000 per year. Assistantships in *music theory*, *music history* and *facilities management* may also be available to qualified applicants for different stipend amounts.
