Work We Do

- •Served 2,687 students (May 2022 December 2022) in individual engagements
- •25% increase in individual student appointments compared to last year
- Increase in both face-to-face and virtual appointments
- •69% increase in EAB referrals from Advisors (88 in 2021 vs. 149 in 2022)
- •Students who began their job search 6 months or more prior to graduation earn \$8,200 more
- •Graduates who completed an internship earned \$7, 441 more than those who did not do an internship
- •Recruiters hire 63.9% of their new college hires from their internship and co-op programs (2020)
