- Students will gain additional digital skills across multiple academic areas while learning to think critically about how digital technologies work and the impact these technologies have on society.
- Students have the opportunity to gain in-demand digital skills that prepare them for careers in every field.
- For undergraduate students
 - Must be enrolled in degree program – NOT free standing
 - Awarded in the same semester as BA/BS degree – NOT before/after
- Does not extend time to degree and does not have excessive prerequisites.

 - College of Engineering and Computing (CSCE, ITEC)
 - College of Arts and Sciences (GEOG, MART)

- Upon completion, the student will get a certificate – separate document from the diploma – at the time of BA/BS graduation.




FALL '23 COURSE MODALITIES - REMINDERS
