AlcoholEdu Sexual Assault Prevention for Undergraduates Mental Well-being Diversity, Inclusion and Belonging for Students

AlcoholEdu is an online alcohol education program and assessment that measures students' perceptions about alcohol use prior to arriving on campus and after several weeks on campus.

Sexual Assault Prevention for Undergraduates is an online education and training module that presents realistic and interactive skill-building scenarios.

Mental Well-being is an online course that helps educate students on critical social and emotional well-being topics that they may face on campus and provides strategies on how to manage them.

Diversity, Inclusion & Belonging for Students is an online course that uses a social justice approach to discuss concepts such as inclusion, power, privilege, identities, and communication as well as strategies related to ally behavior, self-care, and creating inclusive spaces.
