 - Advisors within the unit be they faculty, departmental or UAC professional advisors, can be very helpful if included during the process. The advisors are probably the best "point people" for this because faculty don't and aren't going to be dealing with Degreeworks on a regular basis. I found our faculty very amenable to my suggestions on how the new curriculum could be configured in ways that worked better with Degreeworks and also kept the curricular goals paramount.

- Updates from Brian
 - EAB Reminders and Updates and Future
 - Scheduling appointments if you have 45 min appointments, they
 updated the system so you don't have as much wasted times.
 - Direct link for appointments has been giving some trouble. If students use the link and cannot log in, tell students not to use VIPID. They can use their network ID (email and password) or USCID.
 - EAB App Rolling out to students through Orientation, potentially. Brian shows the app more.
 - Fall considerations for advising
 - Online and in person advising. This is a good time to update those things for the upcoming semester.
