Creation of additional USC subject cores bring greater definition to courses without direct equivalent department codes.  The change improves how courses are applied to degree requirements, particular in DegreeWorks.  Examples DAMT (Dance, Art, Music, Theatre) are transfer courses that do not have direct equivalents at USC, but are clearly courses that align with Dance, Art, Music, and/or Theatre. | Transfer Probation & Academic Recovery (policy) | Students who transfer to the University of South Carolina face additional challenges related to transfer shock and differences in academic rigor as they acclimate to their new campus culture.  New Transfer Students who are placed on Academic Probation at the end of their first semester of enrollment are considered at risk.  Effective Fall 2023, the academic bulletin was updated to mandate new transfers to participate in Academic Recovery.  First-year freshmen and transfer who have less than a 2.00 Total Institutional GPA at the end of their first semester of collegiate enrollment are considered at risk.  During the first six weeks of their second semester, these students must participate in an academic coaching session before being eligible to register for courses for the third semester. | Early Transfer Academic Advisement (procedure)  | Opportunity for admitted transfers to meet with an academic advisor prior to attending New Student Orientation. 771 transfer students were admitted as part of the Early Transfer Academic Advisement initiative for Fall 2023.  93% of those who attended an early transfer academic advisement appointment enrolled at the University of South Carolina for Fall 2023.  The Early Transfer Academic Advisement initiative began Fall 2022.  |
