GIVE 4 GARNET UPDATE



- Give 4 Garnet was held on April 19 for 18 hours and 01 minute (5:59am - midnight)
- Goal was 3,000 donors
- USC raised more than \$816k from 6,450 donors, which is the highest number in G4G's history.
- Of the 6,450 donors:
 - 2,750 were first-time donors to USC, which is highest number first-time donors in G4G's history.
 - 3,260 are alumni donors
 - 591 were students
 - 1,516 were current USC employees, which is the highest number employee donors in G4G's history



GIVE 4 GARNET BOT CHALLENGE IDEAS

Beat Your Best" Challenge

- The top ten colleges and units can unlock bonus funds. The area with the largest percentage increase of donors from Giving Day 2023 wins additional funds.
- The funds would be ranked by percentage increases over the previous year.
- The number one most improved fund would get 20% (for example) of the challenge money, number two would get 10%, and the percentage decreases as the ranking is lower.
- This challenge allows all colleges and units to have an opportunity to compete and win bonus funds.

• 2-4-6 Challenge

- Donors number 2K, 4K and 6K will unlock additional funds for their favorite college or unit.
- The advantage of this challenge is that it will drive up donor numbers.
