Methodology for Emergency Financial Aid Grants Under Section 314(a)(1) of the ARP Act

To receive a HEERF III Federal Grant for the Fall 2021 term, students must have been enrolled for the current Fall 2021 term in a degree program prior to October 6, 2021.

Based on additional guidance provided through The American Rescue Plan Act, UofSC Aiken developed the following plan for awarding and disbursing the funds.

Student Populations Excluded from the Distribution:

- Students enrolled as Non-degree

All students were awarded emergency grant amounts based on 1) Financial Aid eligibility and 2) enrollment status.

- Undergraduate Students, filed a 2021-22 FAFSA, receiving Pell Grant, enrollment status (12+, 9-11, 6-8, 1-5 credits)
- Undergraduate Students, filed a 2021-22 FAFSA, not eligible for Pell, enrollment status (12+, 9-11, 6-8, 1-5 credits)
- Undergraduate Students, did not file a 2021-22 FAFSA, enrollment status (12+, 9-11, 6-8, 1-5 credits)
- Graduate Students, filed a 2021-22 FAFSA, enrollment status (6+, 1-5 credits)
- Graduate Students, did not file a 2021-22 FAFSA, enrollment status (6+, 1-5 credits)
