- The published rental rate (fair market value), and

- A separate line item for each person,

- The dates of service,
- The type of service, and
- The total rate of pay (fair market value).

All reported in-kind items must be:

- Provided by a third-party, either by an individual or an organization, <u>not</u> the University.
- For allowable costs and activities that are included in the approved project budget.
- Supported by documentation that substantiates the fair value of the goods or services provided.

While you may use allowable third-party in-kind contributions to meet the cost share requirement for your sponsored project, you <u>cannot</u> be reimbursed for in-kind donations.
