

Import the Center for Teaching Excellence (CTE) Blackboard Learn Ultra Course View (UCV) Template into a Blackboard UCV Course

- 1. Open a web browser (e.g., Chrome or Firefox) and log into <u>Blackboard</u> (https://blackboard.sc.edu/)
- 2. Open a new tab on the web browser and copy <u>https://blackboard.sc.edu/bbcswebdav/xid-</u> 222146725 4 into the address bar to download the template.

Note: The file is called "ExportFile_CTE_ULTRA-TEMPLATE-SAND.zip" and is downloaded to the "Downloads" folder on your computer.

- 4. Click the "More Options for Course Content" icon in the upper right corner of the screen
