



Global Fellows Living & Learning Community Travel Grant Requirements

Applicant Eligibility

Eligible applicants must be undergraduate students [in good standing](#) who are current or former members of the Global Fellows Living & Learning Community. First-time applicants have priority, but you can apply for and be awarded the travel grant more than once.

Program Eligibility

Travel grants must be used for USC-approved education abroad programs, study away programs, or research projects. They may be used for Semester, Academic Year, Spring Break, Winter Break, Maymester, and Summer study abroad programs as well as short-term travel within or outside of the US for programs related to international and inter-cultural education. USC-approved programs include programs organized by USC as well as programs hosted by university partners. Most USC-approved programs will be listed in the [Education Abroad Program Directory](#) or on USC academic department websites. If you are unsure whether or not your program is a USC-approved program, please reach out to Rachael Allen (allenre@mailbox.sc.edu) with questions.

Award Terms

Travel grant amounts range from \$500-\$1,000 for students living off campus and from \$500-1,500 for student living in South Quad, depending on application and availability of funds. **Applications for Spring 2026 are due by March 4, 2026. Fall 2026 applications are due by November 1, 2026.** Funds for winners will not be dispersed until proof of program participation (for example, program fee deposits or official confirmation emails from program providers) is sent to allenre@mailbox.sc.edu. You cannot defer the award. It must be used for the term listed on your application. If the term of your program changes, you must reapply.
