I am writing to notify the Commission on Colleges of the following program termination within the College of Arts and Sciences.

Doctor of Philosophy in Clinical-Community Psychology

- Students will no longer be admitted starting Fall 2021.
- The College of Arts and Sciences is consolidating the Ph.D. programs Experimental Psychology, Clinical-Community Psychology and School Psychology into a single Ph.D. in Psychology program.
- Termination of the program has been communicated to and voted on by the faculty and students have been informed of the program termination.
- The faculty members who teach the specialized classes in the Clinical-Community Psychology program will teach the required courses for the Clinical-Community concentration of the Ph.D. in Psychology program.
- All currently declared Clinical-Community students will continue to be supported and we will continue to offer the necessary courses until they complete their degrees.
