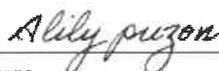

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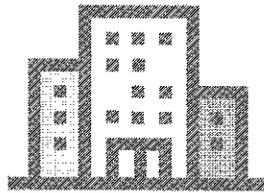

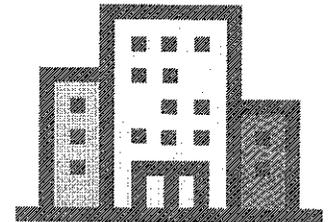

We are seeking a faculty member who studies the effects of environmental stressors on the functional physiology of marine, estuarine, or freshwater animals. The successful candidate will join colleagues in the Institute for Clean Water and Healthy Ecosystems, a newly established partnership between USC and the South Carolina Department of Environmental Services, whose mission is to catalyze and coordinate USC research efforts in scientific and socioeconomic aspects of water quality.
