IMPROVING THE TFAC HIRING PROCESS IN ARTS AND SCIENCES

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PURPOSE

- Streamline the process by which Arts and Sciences approves the hiring of approximately 1,300 temporary faculty each year
- Impacts HR, Budget, faculty credentialing, enrollment management, and unit hiring practices/timelines in the College

WHY?

- Bottleneck in approvals leading to late hires
- Need for accurate data
- Limitations of software
- Reduce time spent on duplication, loopbacks, and corrections

Units will receive approval to hire TFAC without need to submit a form.


Data to be university-generated, rather than manually input, reducing inaccuracies.

Approval months earlier than current process.



RESULTS

- ✓ Projected immediate decline in late TFAC hires
- ✓ Accurate data for budget reconciliation
- ✓ Reduction in loopbacks and duplication
- ✓ Central shared location for data
- ✓ Time given back to departments






NEXT STEPS
