



TOP 10 FACILITATION TOOLS

Use these tools to bring out the best in a group

These 10 tools are easy to use, extremely effective, and guaranteed to help you get more done with groups. For guidance and examples, go to sc.edu/excellence.

1. **Root Cause Analysis:** Pinpoint the real reason behind a problem, helping your team focus on lasting solutions.
2. **Pareto Diagram:** Identify the most impactful issues, so you can focus efforts where they'll make the biggest difference.
3. **Brainstorming:** Spark creativity, foster collaboration, and generate a wealth of ideas – quickly.
4. **Brainwriting:** Capture thoughtful contributions from all participants, ensuring all voices are heard without pressure.
5. **Carousel Process:** Rotate subgroups through different stations to get comprehensive input and collaboration.
6. **Impact/Effort Grid:** Prioritize efforts by balancing the potential impact of actions with the required effort.
7. **Dot Voting:** Move toward consensus visually by having participants place dots to mark their top choices.
8. **Decision Matrix:** Narrow in on a decision by evaluating multiple options using a small set of meaningful criteria.
9. **Affinity Diagram:** Organize ideas into clear themes, helping the team see patterns and draw conclusions.
10. **Gantt Chart:** Show project timelines and dependencies in a single visual to keep an effort on track.

Pro Tip: Combine tools to be even more productive. For example start with **brainwriting**, then build an **affinity diagram** to process the ideas, then use **dot voting** to lift out priorities.
