MYHEALTHSPACE

Your patient portal during your time at UofSC

- Upload medical forms and insurance cards
- Complete medical clearance forms
- Schedule appointments
- Review and print immunizations
- Communicate with your providers at University Health Services with secure messages



REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS

- **Two MMR Vaccines** (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
 - Acceptable evidence of immunity against measles includes at least one of the following:
 - Written documentation of adequate vaccination (two doses)
 - Laboratory evidence of immunity (titers)
 - Laboratory confirmation of measles

Exemptions:

- A documented medical exemption from a healthcare provider (allergic)
 - A signed notarized statement of religious exemption
 - **Philosophical exemptions DO NOT meet this requirement**
- **Meningococcal Vaccine** (Menevo or Menactra)
- **TB Risk Screening** (sc.edu/myhealthspace)

HEALTH INSURANCE

- Students must have health insurance
- All students enrolled in 6+ credit hours must show proof of health insurance
 - Purchasing the Student Health Insurance Plan
 - Waiving plan and providing proof of your own health insurance at sc.myahpcare.com
 - **Students must waive or enroll each semester**
- Failure to show proof of health insurance will result in automatic enrollment in the Student Health Insurance Plan.
- Premium is due with fall and spring tuition
 - Fall 2021: \$1,097
 - Spring/Summer 2021: \$1,494



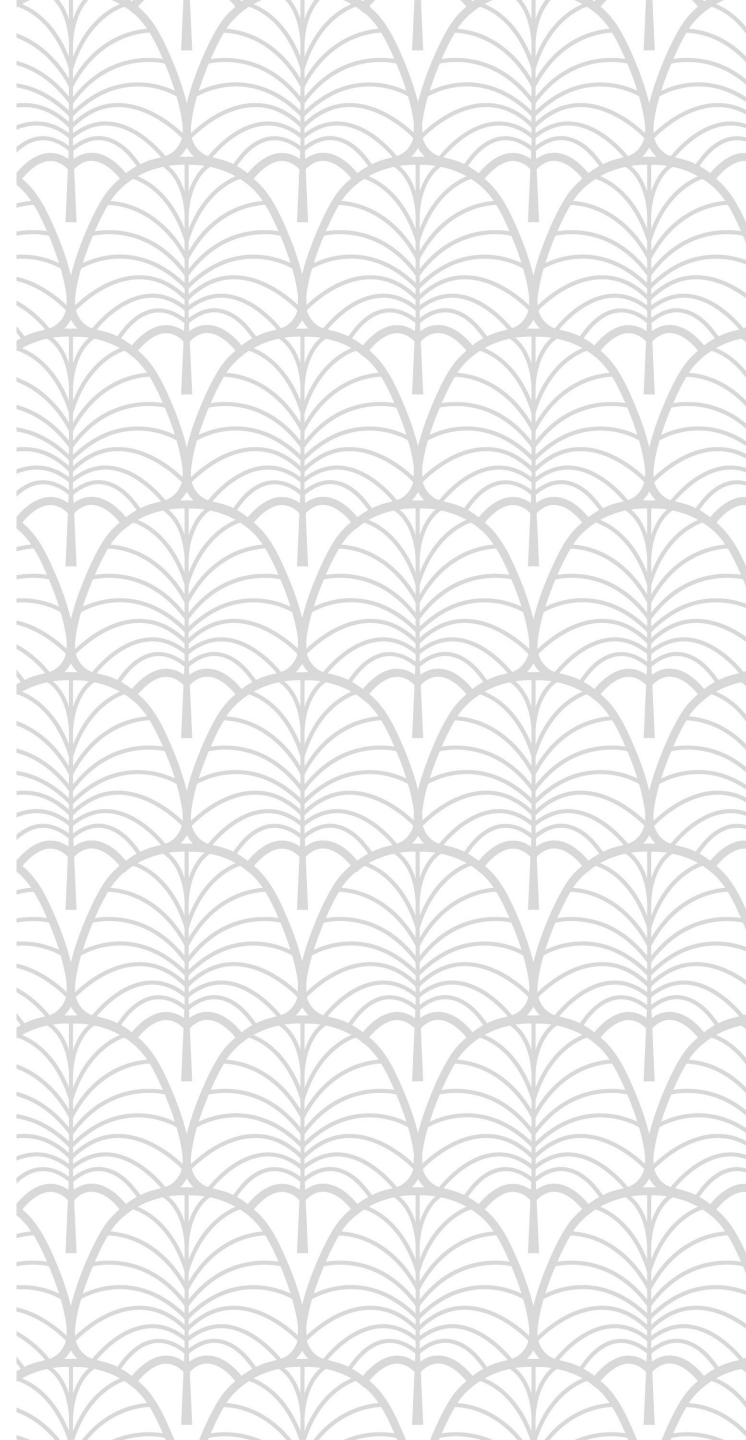
HEALTH INSURANCE

- University-sponsored **Student Health Insurance Plan** is only **in-network** plan at University Health Services
- Our pharmacy is **in-network** with most insurance plans
- Provide the health center your insurance and prescription cards now or during your first visit
 - Upload to sc.edu/myhealthspace
- Must give permission to file claims
- All claims will be filed electronically
- All claims are subject to copays, deductibles
- If you have questions about cost, insurance or billing, please call 803-777-3174

STUDENT HEALTH FEE

\$190 per semester includes:

- Primary Care office visits
- Women's Health office visits
- Access to individual counseling visits
- Group counseling
- Support groups and workshops
- Preventive screenings
- Wellness coaching
- Clinical nutrition, stress management or sexual health consultations



STUDENT HEALTH FEE

Billed to your health insurance:

- Radiology (X-rays, EKGs)
- Laboratory services
- Prescriptions
- Physical therapy
- Psychiatric services
- Allergy shots and other vaccines
- Travel consultations
- Services received at any other hospital or clinic
- Charges for no-show appointments

Students are responsible for any applicable deductibles, copays and coinsurance.



RELEASES FOR FAMILIES

- Students are considered adults. Your medical information cannot be released without your written consent.
- Students must give permission to the provider to release information to parents or guardians for each individual issue, per HIPAA and UofSC policy.
- Parent or emergency medical contact will be notified if there is a medical emergency.

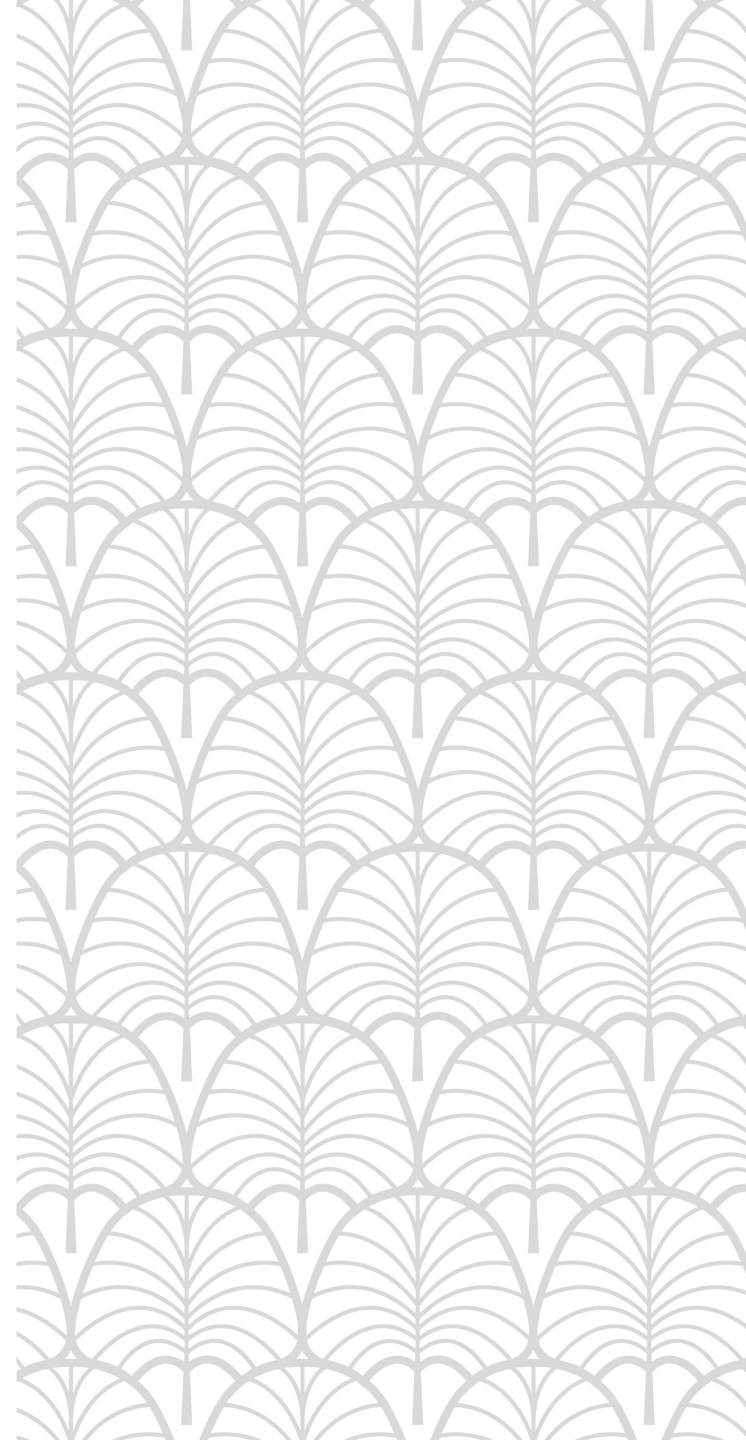
Proof of vaccination

Upload a copy of your vaccine card in your MyHealthSpace account by going to Messages – Send a New Message and select the option to upload your COVID Vaccination Record.

Vaccine Clinic on Campus

Visit our COVID Vaccine Clinic on-campus on Day 2 of your orientation in the Center for Health and Well-Being. No appointment necessary. Must be 18. Janssen vaccine will be available.
