- VA will process your initial application and provide a Certificate of Eligibility by mail (COE)
- Complete Enrollment Certification Request Form (ECR) @ sc.edu/ecr
- After signing up for classes each semester complete the ECR as soon as possible to ensure timely processing by our office and timely payment by VA

Active Duty Tuition Discount

UofSC has an Active Duty tuition discount available to both active duty servicemembers as well as active National Guard and Reserve members.

Veterans Choice Act - Resident Tuition Waiver

Recently separated servicemembers, or their dependents, who are not South Carolina Residents can complete an application with the Residency Office to waive their out-of-state tuition.

Priority Registration

Available for any military-affiliated student. Those using benefits will automatically be signed up after their first semester. For those who are not using benefits, you will need to complete the Priority Registration Form under the Resources link on sc.edu/veterans.
