

# 2019 Breakthrough Graduate Scholars Awards Guidelines and Criteria

## Rationale

Each spring, the Office of the Vice President for Research names selected graduate students as Breakthrough Graduate Scholars. These graduate students have excellent academic records, have made significant contributions to research and scholarship in their field of study, and have clearly demonstrated the potential to make exceptional professional contributions to research and scholarly activity. The Breakthrough Graduate Scholar Award recognizes these graduate students for their achievements and celebrates their potential for further success.

## **Award Description**

The recipients of this non-cash award are featured in a supplement to *Breakthrough* magazine, and may be featured on USC websites and other publications. Additionally, they are invited to attend the annual Breakthrough Awards Dinner, held each spring. The award raises awareness of the importance of commitment to research and scholarship both during and beyond graduate study. *Breakthrough* magazine and its supplement are widely distributed to all faculty and administration, peer institutions, program managers, legislative representatives, and selected alumni and donors.

## Award Review Criteria

The Breakthrough Awards Committee will evaluate the nomination materials based on the strength of evidence for the following criteria:

- The nominee should have an excellent academic record with a minimum cumulative graduate GPA of 3.3.
- The nominee should have made significant contributions to research and/or scholarly activity in their field of study.
- The nominee should demonstrate the potential to make exceptional professional contributions to research and scholarly activity.

## Eligibility

- Current graduate students from any discipline in their second year or later.
- December graduates are eligible.
- Nominees who were not selected in previous years are eligible for re-nomination.
- Past recipients of the award are not eligible.
- Nominations are submitted by the graduate program director or equivalent.

With prior approval from the Vice President for Research, certain eligibility criteria may be waived in unusual circumstances.

#### Nomination Procedures

Nominations for the Breakthrough Graduate Scholars award are submitted online through a nomination system based on USC's sponsored awards proposal routing system USCeRA, a familiar interface for most USC faculty members. Both the nominee and the nominator have a role to play in completing nomination package components both inside and outside of the nomination system. Completed nomination packages are finalized and submitted to the Office of Research by the nominator.

Complete nomination packets are due no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, October 26, 2018.

## Nomination Package Components

#### Nominees Must Provide:

- Responses of 4,000 characters or fewer (counting spaces and line breaks), for each of the Nominee Questionnaire prompts listed below. (Nominees will have 4,000 characters per response.) We recommend that nominees draft their responses outside of the system, then copy and paste the responses into the Nominee Questionnaire form inside of the nomination system.
  - O Please prepare a personal statement describing your commitment to research and scholarly activity in their field of study.
  - O List major fellowships and awards you have received and the date(s), both at USC and elsewhere.
  - O List significant peer-reviewed publications where you are the author or a co-author, both from USC and elsewhere.
  - O List significant professional presentations, abstracts, exhibitions and/or performances, both associated with USC and elsewhere.

## **Nominators** Must Provide:

• A letter of recommendation, under the nominator's signature, no longer than two pages in length (to be uploaded in PDF format).

## Notes and Exceptions

• Nominators may submit only one 2019 Breakthrough Graduate Scholars Award nomination.

## Selection Process and Timeline

Nominations that are complete and responsive to the requirements of this announcement will be evaluated by the Breakthrough Awards Committee. The committee will evaluate nominations using the award review criteria. The committee will provide a prioritized list of recommended recipients to the Vice President for Research (VPR). The VPR will have final determination of recipients based on the committee's recommendations. Nominees and their nominators will receive notification of their selection or declination on before **Friday, December 7, 2018.**
