What is AFROTC?

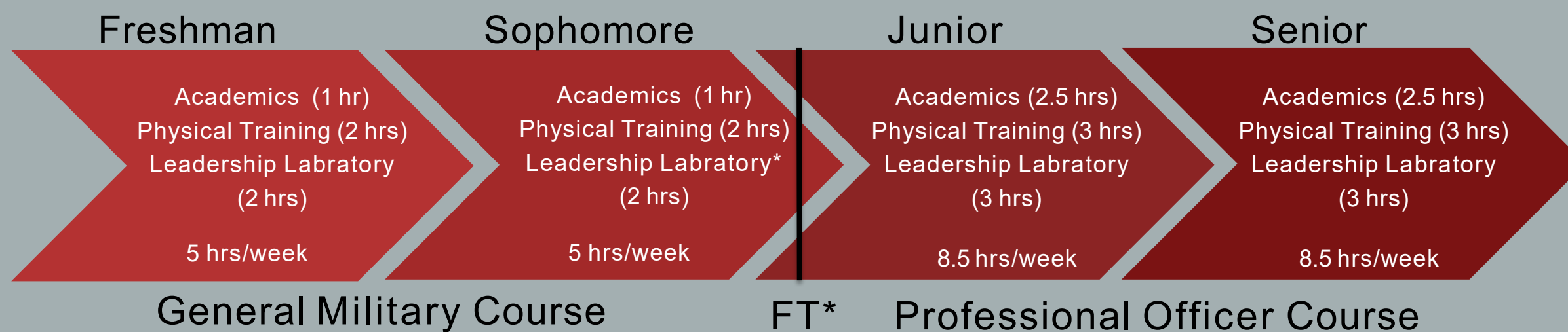

4-Year Timeline



*Field Training (FT): Cadets will compete nationally to be selected to attend FT during the summer between their Sophomore and Junior year. FT is a roughly 3-week summer encampment at Maxwell AFB, AL. While there, cadets are evaluated on their leadership potential, ability to critically think, and overall aptness to commission as an Officer. By completing FT, cadets will advance to the Professional Officer Course as well as be eligible for the *Charles McGee Leadership Award* (2-year scholarship) pending they have completed all previous requirements.

QUESTIONS

What is Leadership Lab (LLAB)/Physical Training (PT)?

LLAB is 2 hr class held once per week where cadets wear their required military uniforms or professional attire to practice skills aimed towards preparing them for FT, and to become a better leader. PT is group exercise held a minimum of 2-times a week based on improving fitness.

Does joining AFROTC require a service obligation?

No! Cadets do not acquire a service obligation until their junior year. Generally, underclassmen could "try out" the program until they receive a scholarship or are "contracted", then may incur a service obligation. Once cadets receive their careers, their service commitment will be determined.

CROSSTOWNS: If you are a crosstown student looking to participate in AFROTC in DET 775, you **MUST** be enrolled as a Non-Degree Seeking student at the University of South Carolina. You **MUST** have this enrollment complete before the semester registration deadline. Please see the University of South Carolina website for information on registration deadlines.
