- sets through these non-traditional platforms and that USC would likely see improved retention and employee satisfaction
- Email Access for Research Employees After Employment Ends: VP Agardy is open to the idea and does not foresee it being a difficult technical endeavor; AVP Ogorek has some concerns about regulating the processes and employees abusing it; we reached out to counterparts in Faculty Senate to learn how academic colleges across campus handle this and if they see a need to investigate further
- RGP Grievance Process Transparency: conflicting information has been dispersed regarding RGP grievance rights; VP Agardy cites HR policy and SC Code of Laws as final answer (no grievance rights); we will have AVP for Civil Rights & Title IX, Peirano, at next meeting to clarify from her perspective; next steps: determine what USC can do/does do and what grant organizations do when onboarding to alleviate confusion
