Abstract

"Thinking Globally" offers your students an exciting first-hand experience focused on expanding their cultural perspectives and global citizenship. Students will learn about different countries of the world through engaging presentations and conversations with USC international students, known as Thinking Globally Ambassadors. The Ambassadors bring to life various aspects of their cultures through the use of visual aids and interactive discussions, often comparing their culture with American culture. Students will also learn how to further their newfound cross-cultural interest by participating in USC programming opportunities, foreign language study, and study abroad.
