- **Monday, November 16, 3 p.m.- “Tricksters” Lecture and Storytelling-** Folklorist and Co-Director of Native American Studies Dr. Stephen Criswell presents a talk about Native American trickster figures. Criswell will be joined by Catawba artist and guest storyteller Beckee Garris.
- **Tuesday, November 17, 3 p.m.- “No Active Warrants” Lecture-** Chippewa visual artist and Savannah College of Art and Design Professor Chris Olszewski discusses his interactive work with canvas automobile covers.
- **Wednesday, November 18, Noon- “Humor and Activism: an artist talk with Tom Farris”-** Otoe-Missouria-Cherokee contemporary artist Tom Farris discusses his satirical works in this presentation.
- **Thursday, November 19, 7 p.m.- Interactive Painting Session-** Artist Tom Farris creates a piece based on audience participation.
- **Friday, November 20, Noon- “Closing the Circle: Repairing Catawba Foodways”-** DeLesslin George-Warren, a citizen of and consultant for the Catawba Indian Nation, discusses the ways that the Catawba Indian Nation is honoring its responsibility to past and future generations by turning towards traditional foodways as a way of creating economic, social, and cultural resiliency in a time of climatic chaos.
