Verification of Active Duty Military Service for Tuition Discount

Active-Duty Tuition Discount: If you are an undergraduate student serving on active duty (see definition below), a member of the National Guard or a reservist, you qualify for a tuition discount. To confirm your current status, you must complete and sign this form and have your Educational Services Officer (ESO) or other authorized unit representative sign this form. Return the completed form to the Financial Aid and Veterans Affairs Office. You must submit this form each semester you are enrolled.

Definition of Active Duty: (1) The term "active duty" means full-time duty in the active military service of the United States. Such term includes full-time training duty, annual training duty, and attendance, while in the active military service, at a school designated as a service school by law or by the Secretary of the military department concerned.
