## **The USCB Psychology degree requires either a COGNATE, a MINOR or a CERTIFICATE**

### **Cognate**

The cognate is a minimum of 12 hours in advanced-level courses related to, but outside, the major. Cognate courses may be drawn from one or more departments, depending on the individual interests and requirements of the student as judged by the academic advisor. A cognate differs from a minor in that the courses must be above prerequisite level and may be distributed over more than one subject area.

### **Minors**

The minor is a minimum of 18 hours. Fully online minors currently offered at USCB include minors in Human Services, Hospitality Management, Medical and Health Humanities, Public Health and Sociology. There are many other minors available to students who are on-campus – all of which are listed in the university bulletin.

### **Certificates**

Certificates are available only to students who are concurrently enrolled in a bachelor's degree program. The certificate and the BA degree are earned simultaneously; the certificate will be awarded along with the BA degree upon graduation. Courses used to satisfy requirements for the certificate may apply toward a student's general education or program requirements but cannot be applied toward the major. USCB offers a Certificate in Gerontology that can be completed online.

## **USC BEAUFORT PALMETTO COLLEGE TECHNOLOGY REQUIREMENTS**
