In addition to the required courses listed on the previous page, the USC Beaufort Palmetto College Degree Completion Program has other requirements necessary to complete the degree. Also, there are certain technological requirements necessary to be successful in the program.

### UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

These are requirements all USC Beaufort students must complete in order to be eligible for graduation. Some requirements are adapted for Palmetto College students.

- **Global Citizenship and Multicultural Understanding Studies:** All USCB students are required to take one course to satisfy this requirement. Ideally, this requirement is met with another required course. However, if you have transferred courses into all of the areas where this requirement can be met, you will have to take a separate Global Citizenship/Multicultural course. Your Palmetto College Advisor will help you identify areas where this requirement can be met.
