I authorize release of information provided above to the United States Air Force (USAF). I also authorize the University of South Carolina Sumter (USC Sumter) to provide the USAF with this information from its records at the request of the USAF. I understand that this information is required in order for Shaw Air Force Base (SAFB) to authorize me access to the classrooms on SAFB. I understand the USAF will be conducting security screening and a background check on me based on this information and that based on its finding may deny me access to the classrooms on SAFB.

I further understand:

1. The use of this information is at the discretion of the USAF.
2. The USAF may disclose the results of its investigation to others, at their discretion.
3. While on property controlled by the USAF, I am subject its rules and regulations.
4. I am responsible for dropping the classes to which I may be denied access in accordance with normal USC procedures. The University will not automatically remove me from class.
5. USC cannot be responsible for the consequences of the USAF denying me access to class. In particular, I understand that I may not be able to find a suitable alternative class and that my academic plans may be affected. The University might not be able to provide me with a full refund of tuition/fees/book costs. Any current financial aid / scholarships/loans may be affected and my eligibility for future financial aid / scholarships / loans may be affected. Normal USC grading policies will apply which may result in a permanent grade of "F", "W", or "WF" being recorded for the course.
