- ✓ 250 degree programs



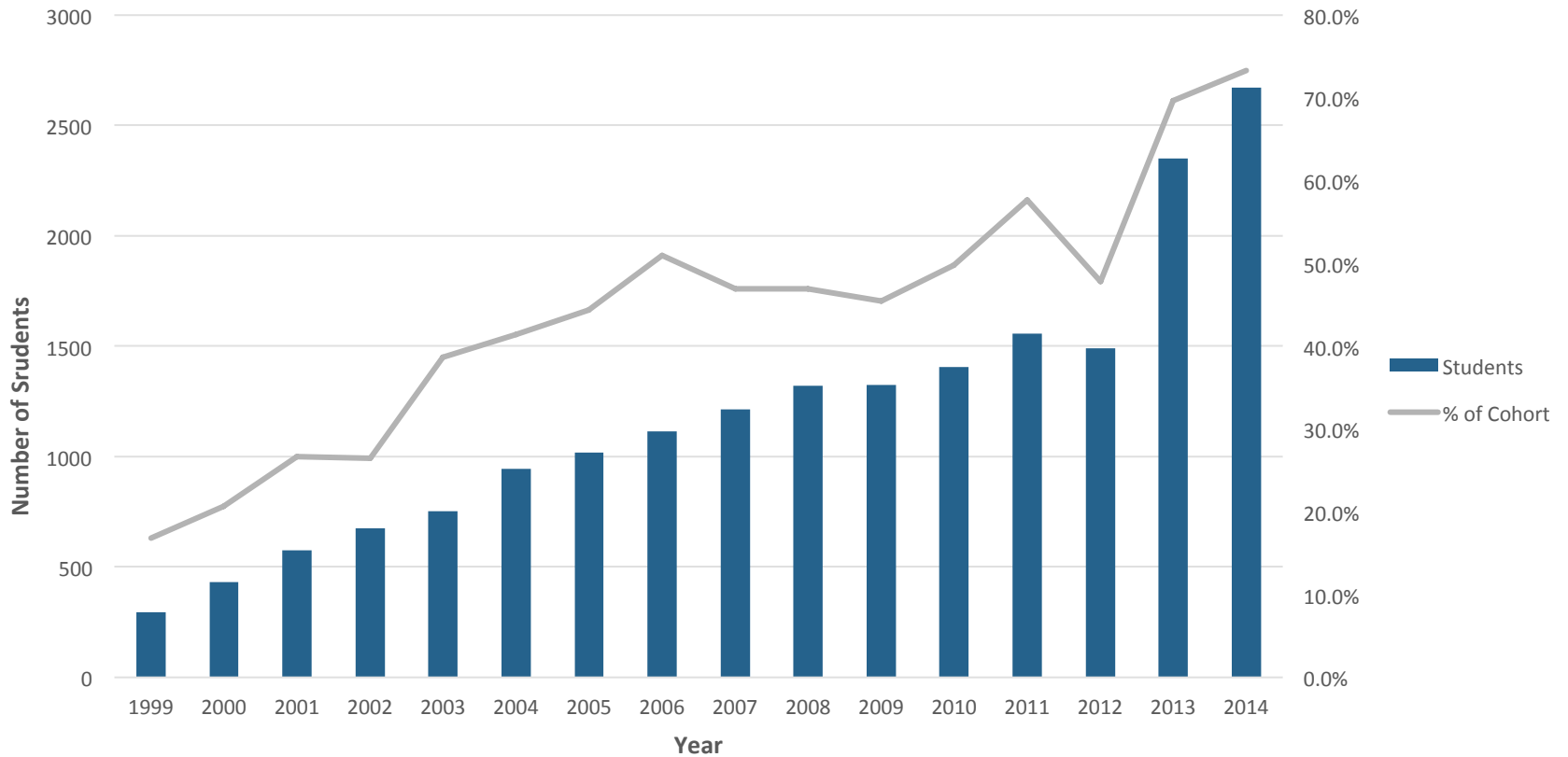
Freshman Learning Communities

- ✓ Registration in common Core Curriculum courses
- ✓ Major-based curriculum
 - Arts and Humanities
 - Business
 - Education
 - Health Sciences
 - Natural Sciences
 - Policy Studies
 - Social Sciences
 - Undecided
- ✓ Choice in schedule type (morning, afternoon, mixed, block)
- ✓ Full fall schedule (5-6 courses for 12-15 credit hours)

Registration Process

✓ 1999-2009

- ✓ Students manually registered by administrators using paper form
- ✓ Hold manually placed on students' records by administrators

✓ 2010-2012

- ✓ Students manually registered by administrators using online form
- ✓ Hold placed on students' records by automatic Banner job

✓ 2013-present

- ✓ Students register themselves during Orientation
- ✓ Hold placed on students' records by automatic Banner job



Group Breakouts

 - Large (> 1,000 students in LC)

- Student Information System:
 - Banner
 - Ad-Astra
