Parent and Family Weekend

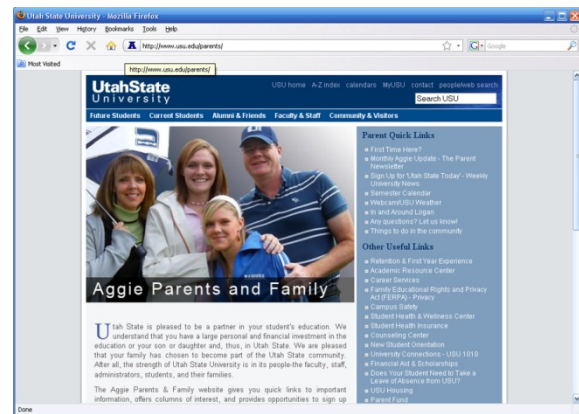
- Activities on campus and in the community, center around brunch/luncheon
