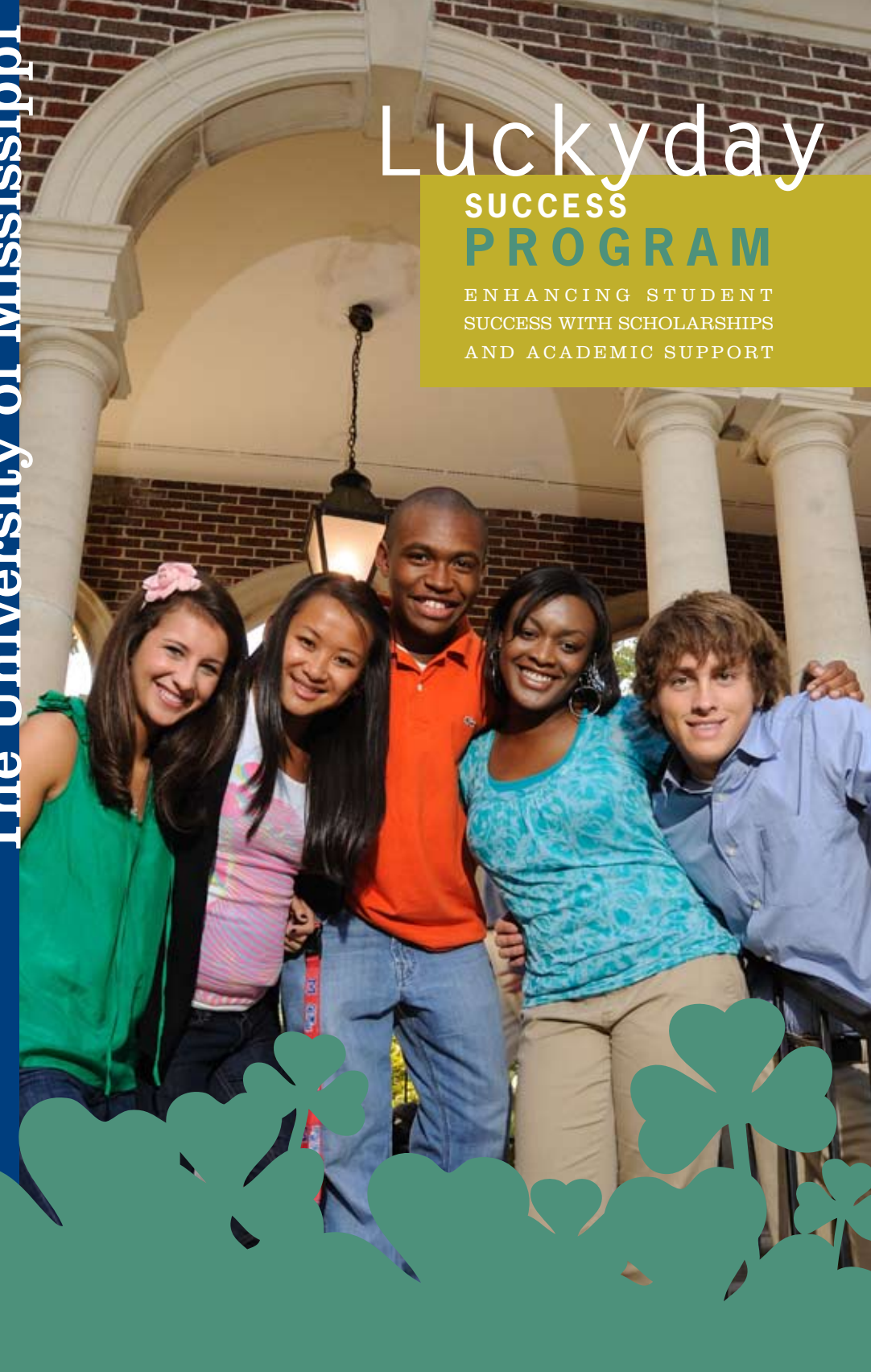

Apply for the Luckyday Scholarship

Requirements

In order to be considered by the Luckyday Scholarship Selection Committee, applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

- * **Enroll as a University of Mississippi freshman**
- * **Meet Mississippi residency requirements**
- * **Score 20 or higher on the ACT** (or SAT score of 930 or higher)
- * **Have a high school GPA of 3.2 or higher** (on 4.0 scale)
- * **Have remaining financial need after awarding of other scholarships and grants**
- * **Meet all application priority deadlines**

To apply for the Luckyday Scholarship, eligible students must submit the following:

FRANK ROGERS DAY

The Luckyday Foundation was founded by Frank Rogers Day, a native of Aberdeen. He was an alumnus of The University of Mississippi and the Graduate School of Banking at Louisiana State University. In addition to serving as chairman of the board and CEO of Trustmark National Bank, Day committed himself to helping young Mississippians achieve their educational goals. In 1978, he established the Luckyday Foundation to do just that. Although Day died in 1999, his vision lives on through his foundation, which continues to support deserving Mississippi students.
