□ Technology capabilities

- In-house or hire out
- Level of support from your institution
 - IT, Media Services, Marketing, Web Developer
- ADA compliant

Step 3: Evaluate & organize content

- Assemble & organize your content
 - Outlines
 - Flowcharts
 - Diagrams
 - Tip: the more detailed the better!

Step 4: Put data into action!

- Determine a vendor or software
 - Articulate Studio Pro
 - Interactive version of PowerPoint
 - Video, quizzes, surveys, diagrams, audio
 - www.articulate.com
 - \$699 for 2 installations
