Transfer has become the norm for undergraduate students

Most students enroll with intent to transfer to a four year institution

More than 80% of CC students intend to earn a bachelor's degree, yet only 17% complete within 6 years

Challenges Transfer Students Experience

- Articulation issues and credit loss
- Lack of clear information regarding transfer online
- Inaccurate advising
- Unclear transfer policies
- Untimely admissions notifications and credit evaluations
- Transitional trauma
- Transfer shock



The Transfer Pathway Program

- Goal: to help students transfer smoothly and graduate efficiently
- Dual-admission, dual-enrollment
- UH Mānoa MOU with all UH CC campuses:
 - o 2008 Kapi'olani CC
 - 2014 Honolulu CC, Leeward CC, Windward CC
 - 2015 UH Maui College
 - 2018 Hawai'i CC and Kaua'i CC

Eligibility Requirements

- Declare a UHM Major
- Have 24 transferable credits completed
 OR 12 transferable credits completed and
 12 in progress OR accepted into UH
 Mānoa right out of high school
- GPA: 2.0 for residents, 2.5 for nonresidents
- No prior bachelor's degree earned
- Not on probation/suspension/dismissal from UHM
- International students need to have completed ENG 100 or ESL 100 or have valid TOEFL scores
- Have at least one semester remaining at the UHCC

Ka'ie'ie Assessment

- Exit Survey respondents report overall experience as very successful (45.45%)
 or successful (54.55%)
- Ka'ie'ie Transfers have increased
 - o 2013 2014 AY = 30
 - o 2016 2017 AY = 183
- Native Hawaiian or Part Hawaiian Ka'ie'ie Transfers have increased
 - 2013 2014 AY = 6
 - 2016 2017 AY = 36
- International Ka'ie'ie Transfers have increased
 - o 2013 2014 AY = 2
 - 2016 2017 AY= 24

Ka'ie'ie Assessment continued

- Ka'ie'ie degree earners from UH Mānoa have slightly higher cumulative GPAs when compared to other transfer students.
- Ka'ie'ie transfer students have a higher semester-to-semester retention rate when compared to other transfer students.
- Ka'ie'ie students report that the accessibility of advising for UH Mānoa and clear direction are some of the best things about the program.
 - "They were there with me through all of the steps"
 - "The ability to talk to a counselor and figure out classes and requirements was really helpful because I had a lot of questions that could not be answered online".

- Transform our center into a true transfer center:
 - Regular office hours
 - Welcome Center
 - Transfer advising for prospective and all incoming transfer students
 - Mentorship program
 - Transition course
- Direct line to admissions and financial aid

- A dedicated transfer specialist at each community college campus
- Better access to data to assess success
- Expanding Ka'ie'ie or creation of similar programs for our sister 4-year campuses (UH Hilo and UH West O'ahu)
