Q1 - Will the contractor be required to have a state issued pesticide license?

A1- Yes, in accordance with State requirements, a current and valid SC Pesticide License is required to be held by the vendor.

Q2- Will a valid driver's license be required for contractors operating motor vehicles on campus?

A2 – Yes, in accordance with State Law, all persons who operate a motor vehicle on the property must possess a current and valid driver's license.
