## **Questions and Answers**

1. Can you only bid on what my business specializes in (janitorial and floor cleaning)?

The University cannot tell a company which lot(s) of the solicitation it can or cannot bid on. Interested vendors need to read the requirements/specifications for each lot in the solicitation and decide which lot(s) they can best perform to.

2. Can I bid on partial parts of the bid?

You must bid on the entire lot. Section II B (page 11) of the solicitation states, "Offers may be submitted for one or more complete lots. Failure to offer on all items within a lot will be reason for rejection."

3. Is the prices in the charts the prices that is going to be paid for each jobs?

The prices are the maximum amount that the University will pay for each job.

4. Are the painting part of the bid going to be done before the cleaning and floors?

Yes.

5. Could I bid only on the cleaning part of the offer and not the painting?

Yes.

6. What is ment by "Full Unit Services"?

This refers to when the entire unit (regardless of being a 1,2,3,4 or 5 bedroom) is done. Alternatively, a partial unit is when just one bedroom is done (usually during the school year when a student moves out).

7. Would my bid still be considerd, if my submitted price is higher than your listed price

No. Section II B (page 12) of the solicitation states, "Fixed Price Bidding. The purpose of fixed price bidding is to provide multiple sources of supply for specific services, supplies, or information technology based on a preset maximum price which the State will pay for such services, supplies, or information technology."

8. My company do cleaning as well as painting. My question is are we able to bid both?

Yes. Section II B (page 11) of the solicitation states, "Offers may be submitted for one or more complete lots. Failure to offer on all items within a lot will be reason for rejection."
