QUESTIONS FROM OFFERORS - AMENDMENT (JUN 2017)

The solicitation is amended as provided herein. Information or changes resulting from questions will be shown in a question-and-answer format. All questions received have been reprinted below. PURPOSE OF AMENDMENT

The purpose of Amendment 2 is to include answers for questions received prior to deadline for questions about the solicitation.

1. Please further define the requirement for compatibility with Gaumard S3101.PK.M /Scope of Work Line Item #3 - Manikin Integration Control Area. Are you asking for full manikin data integration, including seamless data log and event capture?

Yes, full manikin integration, data log and event capture is needed.

2. Per Clause #07-7B115-1, please identify any required permits or inspection fees, either anticipated or potential.

Offerors shall disregard clause LICENSES AND PERMITS on page 75.

3. Can respondents propose modifications/request changes to the RFP's terms and conditions?

Offerors shall bid as specified.

4. Please confirm if offers can be submitted solely by email? Are paper/print copies by mail required?

The answer to this question is provided in the original solicitation:

- 5. How many rooms do you wish to record?

Two rooms.

6. How many simultaneous recordings to you intend to capture?

We may need to record both rooms simultaneously.

7. Do you have a floorplan available? If so, could you please provide us?

There will be two adjacent Sym-Lab rooms, about 12x12 feet each, with one-way windows for instructor monitoring.

8. Do you plan to capture patient monitors in the spaces? If so how many?

We would need to capture one monitor per room.

9. What kind of simulations do you intend to run (high-fidelity, standardized patients, OSCEs, etc.)?

We would run high fidelity simulations and add standardized patients over the next 2 years. We do not currently record OSCEs.

10. You outlined control stations in the bid, how many control stations would you like?

We need to be able to record each room individually which I would think would necessitate two stations but in the same control room.

11. Are you looking for basic functionality of recording and debriefing or a more robust system with a fully outfitted Learning Management Solution (LMS)?

We need basic recording with the ability to show videos to students on a monitor during debriefing.

12. Do you plan to live view the sessions as they take place as part of the workflow?

Yes, we need to be able to have a group of students watching the sessions live from another classroom.

13. We noticed that you include Sony PTZ cameras along with other specified AV equipment in the bid. Are you open to substitute products with similar functionality?

We are open to other products as long as they have the same functionality.

14. Are you looking for a cloud-based solution or an on-premise solution for data centralization?

We can work with a cloud based system for sharing videos and live streaming as needed. If the on-premise solution works as well then that is fine provided enough storage is available.

15. Is the 30 day item delivery date set (pg. 12)? With the current COVID-19 situation we are curious to learn more about your desired timeline and if you are open to receiving/installing the system in a different timeframe.

We are seeking to have the project completed by June 30, 2020.

16. We noticed in the RFP that you directly outline a preferred vendor for the solution. Have you spoken to other vendors about bid submissions as well?

The purpose of this solicitation is to seek competition. The University prepared the specifics/scope of work based on the needs of University. It is in the University's best interest to seek competition, and in doing so, welcomes bids from all qualified vendors.

17. We do not furnish LCD TV screens, windows computers, or pull cabling to set the POE drops as part of our solution. Are you open to purchasing this equipment yourself?

Offerors shall bid as specified.

18. We would like to verify that per Page 1, the University is accepting emailed submissions of the bid responses, rather than requiring a physical copy be mailed in?
