- Item 9: Eliminate metal lockers in all locations (-\$4500.00)
- Item 10: Eliminate new metal railing at loading dock (5/1.2) and at existing exterior Stair (8/A1.1) **ELECTRICAL**
- Item 11: In Unfinished Spaces 119A, 119B, 110C and 120, eliminate all light fixtures with the exception of LED Exit/Emergency signage (-\$2500.00)
- Item 12: In Unfinished Spaces 119A, 119B,119C and 120, eliminate 8 of 12 receptacles (-\$2500.00) PLUMBING
- Item 13: In Restrooms 115 and 116, remove all sensor flush valves and faucets and provide to be manually operated (-\$500.00)
