## THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS WERE RECEIVED FROM VENDOR A:

**QUESTION #1:** Who is the current vendor, and how long have they been operating on the campus?

ANSWER: A&A Vending Services/Dixie Riverside, Inc. was awarded the current contract on June 19, 2015. They have successfully retained the account for 20+ years.

**QUESTION # 2:** Do you have the total sales broken down by machine in each area? As the reported total sales of \$32,100 is low for 12 months, we would like to see if we can subtract machines from the areas where the sales are lower.

ANSWER: Total sales by machine in each area are not available. Machines have been strategically placed throughout campus to best serve the campus community and the universities intention is for the number of machines and locations to remain the same. Contractor is encouraged to be creative in either marketing, offerings, technology or other methods to grow sales.
