THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS WERE RECEIVED FOR FURTHER CLARIFICATION FROM VENDOR A

Question 1:

Item 4: You are getting four Dimmer Packs, I believe this means you will need four sets of Tie-ins. Do you want one as specified or four?

Answer:

Yes, USC needs 4 sets of tie-ins

Question 2:

Item 5: You are getting four Dimmer Packs, I believe this means you will need four sets of CamLock Cables. Do you want one as specified or four?

Answer:

Yes, USC needs 4 sets of Cam-locks

Question 3:

Item 6: Do you want a C-clamp, Plug and Safety Cable with the PAR 56 fixtures?

Answer:

Yes.

Ouestion 4:

Item 15: Do you want a Lamp with these fixtures? If so, what wattage?

Answer:

The PAR 56's are slotted to be LED fixtures and so the lamps should be the LED lamps that are part of those fixtures already.

Ouestion 5:

Item 16: What length and quantities of cables do you want?
