ITEM ONE: QUESTIONS FROM VENDOR(S)

QUESTION #1

The general conditions specify that the contractor must provide a 5 year warranty. Will you please define what the warranty will specifically cover? For example: Will it cover a bat in the building or a colony of bats? Will it cover acts of God or water damage? Open windows? Window AC units? The structural integrity of the building? Etc.

Answer #1:

QUESTION #2

Line "G" on page 12 in General Conditions should be better defined and more specific. There is a lot of water damaged areas to the existing building due to the hidden gutter design. Your statement of repairs, in my opinion in the General Conditions, is asking for total recondition of the hidden gutter and soffit areas of the building in order to prevent future reoccurrence of bats in the building. This would be a major undertaking just to prevent bats from entering a building. I would recommend that it is required to repair these areas of water damage in order to prevent bats from entering until USC can hire a contractor to remove the hidden gutter and soffit areas to be restored to historic standards. Will you please be specific as to how these areas should be repaired for the "Bat Removal" and the expected condition of these areas for final contract?
