1. Is it possible to bid only on the items we can supply? Some of these items have protected distribution and we do not have access to them.

Offerors may provide response to individual lots if it was broken down by manufacture.

- 2 Items 22 - 33 do not require alterations because they come in specific waist and length sizes out of the box, so can we submit a product only bid on these items, and exclude bidding on the others we cannot supply?

- 3 Items 22 – 33 have a lead time from the manufacturer of 7 to 10 business days, will that be acceptable?

Contractor must maintain an inventory of uniforms purchased so as to be able to outfit new or existing personnel within 2-3 days of issuance of purchase order. The stock inventory must include female shirts and trousers.
