ITEM ONE: DEADLINE FOR RECEIPT OF BIDS EXTENDED

Must submit offer by May 15, 2014, 2:00 PM

ITEM TWO: AWARD POSTING EXTENDED

Award posting has been extended until May 16, 2014.

ITEM THREE: BID SCHEDULE REVISED ATTACHED, OPTION ADDED

USC has added separate line items in Lot II to include replacement of the following, quantity unknown:

- Cardboard Replacement
- Drawer Glide Replacement
- Drawer Pull Replacement

ITEM FOUR: ADD THE FOLLOWING BID CLAUSE TO SECTION II. INSTRUCTIONS TO OFFERORS - B.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

OFFERING BY LOT: Offers must be submitted for one or more complete lots. Failure to offer on all items within a lot will be reason for rejection.

ITEM FIVE: ADD THE FOLLOWING BID CLAUSE TO SECTION VII. TERMS AND CONDITIONS - B.

SPECIAL

ESTIMATED QUANTITY - UNKNOWN (JAN 2006): The total quantity of purchases of any individual item on the contract is not known. The State does not guarantee that the State will buy any specified item or total amount. The omission of an estimated purchase quantity does not indicate a lack of need but rather a lack of historical information.

ITEM SIX: VENDOR QUESTIONS / CLARIFICATION

QUESTION:

Mirror - Will contractor replace or re-use and re-glue existing cardboard backing?

ANSWER:

Contractor will re-use, repair, adjust included with base bid costs.

However, USC has added a Unit price for replacement of the cardboard, see Revised Bid Schedule.

OUESTION:

Mirror - That contractor will be responsible for the removal of any tape or stickers on mirrors along with cleaning any glue residue off of glass.

ANSWER:

Yes. This is to be included with the base bid costs.

QUESTION:

Drawers - Will we handle broken or missing drawer guides as one change order for the total at the end of the project or should we bid any needed replacements upfront?

ANSWER:

There should not be any missing. However, USC has added the following in the Revised Bid Schedule:

- Unit price for drawer glide replacement
- Unit price for drawer pull replacement

CLARIFICATION INQUIRY:

I also did want to clarify one additional note that I thought of after I left. To clarify this project will cover wood repair & refinishing of the furniture only. If there are laminate tops on the desk and 5 drawer chest that need repair or replacement that would be outside of the projects scope.

ANSWER:

Clarification of Scope, includes:

- -Cleaning of entire piece, including removal of stickers, glue, tape (including glass mirrors & laminate)
- -Wood repair and refinishing
- -Tightening of all hardware for smooth function of all operational drawers
- -Scratches in Laminate tops on desk and 5 drawer chests are to be color filled only.

NOTE: Any additional repair to the laminate is outside of this project scope.
