THE FOLLOWING QUESTION WAS SUBMITTED BY VENDOR A:

Question: Looking over the Bid request, seem that for items 5 and 6 you are only requesting the license and no subscription? Is this correct?

Answer: Items 1 and 3 of the Bidding Schedule of the solicitation are for replacement licenses (educational to government commercial) – 8 of each kind.

Items 5 and 6 of the Bidding Schedule of the solicitation are for additional licenses the University may be buying at later times. The University anticipates pricing will be different for the additional licenses (items 5 and 6) compared to the replacement licenses (items 1 and 3).

So the items 5 and 6 are for the anticipated different pricing of licenses to be purchased at a later times.

Like licenses in items 1 and 3 of the Bidding Schedule of the solicitation, licenses in items 5 and 6 of the Bidding Schedule of the solicitation will also need subscriptions – no difference in this regard. The reason the University did not include separate items on the Bidding Schedule of the solicitation for subscriptions for additional licenses is because it's the University understanding that subscriptions pricing (items 2 and 4 of the Bidding Schedule of the solicitation) is the same as for those licenses that the University is getting replaced (items 1 and 3 of the Bidding Schedule of the solicitation).
