ITEM ONE: VENDOR QUESTION(S)

Question:

I've noticed on page 4 you've mentioned:

- At the conclusion of the project, the purchased furniture will be sold "asis" via the South Carolina's online auction and the Contractor shall be responsible for on-site disassembling, packaging, removal, and shipping.

Does this apply *to State furniture contractors** if awarded the project or would that for the contractor that purchases the as-is furniture?

Answer

If the university purchases temporary office furniture it becomes property of the state. At the conclusion of the project, the university intends to sell the state-owned property (furniture) through the states on-line auction services. The sale is open to all interested buyers and the successful bidder will be responsible for onsite disassembling, packaging and removal from premises of said property.
