It is the University's expectation that the successful offeror will offer (and provide) employment to all the current full time and temporary custodial workers employed by the University. Currently there are 10 full time employees. If employment is accepted by University employees, these workers are to be employed by the successful offeror for a minimum period of two months. The wage rate paid to these workers by the contractor will be the same as their current wage rate. This information will be provided by the University.

The 10 State workers are either a Band I average pay 15,743/yr (6 of the employees are Band I) or 7.57/hr or a band II average pay is 17,262/yr or 8.30/hr with benefits (4 of the employees are Band II).
